#### Issue:

Approval of an ordinance regarding the right of way for the installation of a new traffic signal and equipment on park district property.

### **Discussion:**

The land on which the traffic lights at Athletic Drive and Dempster Street was never formally given to the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT). The developer of Sawmill Station was directed by IDOT to correct this before Sawmill Station's permits with IDOT can proceed.

### **ORDINANCE NO. 0-03-20**

# ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING RIGHT-OF-WAY CONVEYANCE TO THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION Entrance to Prairie View Community Center

**WHEREAS**, the Morton Grove Park District ("Park District") is organized and operating pursuant to the Illinois Park District Code, 70 ILCS 1205/1-1 et seq. ("Park Code"); and

**WHEREAS,** the Park District is the owner of certain real estate depicted and described in **Exhibit A** ("Subject Property"), situated at the intersection of Dempster Street and the entrance to the Prairie View Community Center, located at 6834 Dempster Street ("Community Center"); and

WHEREAS, for a considerable period of time, traffic signalization equipment owned, operated and maintained by the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") has been located on the Subject Property, to control traffic entering and exiting the Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property was never dedicated, conveyed or otherwise transferred to IDOT, creating confusion and risk for IDOT and the Park District; and

WHEREAS, IDOT is planning certain improvements to the signalization located on the Subject Property to accommodate traffic changes arising from the development of Sawmill Station Lifestyle Center at the southeast corner of Dempster and Waukegan Roads ("Sawmill Station"); and

**WHEREAS,** in order to minimize future risk to the Park District and IDOT, and to facilitate the development of Sawmill Station, the Park Board hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Park District to donate, transfer and convey the Subject Property to IDOT as soon as practicable; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-11 of the Park Code expressly grants the Park District the power to grant right of way for the construction, operation, and maintenance of facilities upon under or across any property owned by the Park District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MORTON GROVE PARK DISTRICT, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE: Incorporation of Recitals**. The foregoing recitals are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein, and all provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed, interpreted, and enforced in accordance therewith. All exhibits referenced herein are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance.

**SECTION TWO: Conveyance Authorized.** The Board of Park Commissioners hereby approves the conveyance of the Subject Property, depicted and legally described in Exhibit A attached hereto, to the Illinois Department of Transportation.

**SECTION THREE: Execution of Transaction.** The Park Board President and Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to execute the instrument of conveyance in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit B**, and to execute any other documents necessary to convey the Subject Property. The Park District Executive Director and Attorney are authorized and directed to take any and all such further action as may be necessary and proper in the premises to effectuate the transaction.

**SECTION FOUR: Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION FIVE: Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its adoption and publication as required by law.



#### Issue:

Approval of an ordinance to appoint a resident to fulfill the vacancy on the Board of Park Commissioners.

### **Discussion:**

A vacancy on the board was created when Mark Manno resigned in February. Rather than conduct a long process to solicit, interview and select a candidate, the Board of Park Commissioners can, through an ordinance, forego established processes when it is in its best interests to do so.

With the referendum approaching the need to fill the vacancy is vital. The Board has selected Mazhar Khan due to his exceptional ties to the community, strong history of volunteerism, having previous applied and ran for a seat on the Board, and his professional experience in the park and recreation field.

Mr. Khan would serve until the next municipal election in 2021.

### Park Board Action:

For the Board of Park Commissioners to approve Ordinance #O-04-20 thereby placing Mazhar Khan to the Board of Park Commissioners.

### ORDINANCE NO. O-04-20

### AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING MAZHAR KHAN TO THE MORTON GROVE PARK DISTRICT BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF COMMISSIONER MARK MANNO

WHEREAS, the Morton Grove Park District ("Park District") is organized and operating pursuant to the Illinois Park District Code, 70 ILCS 1205/1-1 et seq. ("Park Code"); and

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2020, Commissioner Mark Manno resigned from the Board of Park Commissioners of the Morton Grove Park District ("Park Board") effective February 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS the Park Board desires to recognize the resignation of Commissioner Manno, declare a vacancy on the Park Board, and appoint an individual to fill the remainder of Commissioner Manno's term as soon as practicable; and

WHEREAS, the Park District Board of Park Commissioners ("Park Board") previously adopted a Code of General Use Regulations pursuant to Section 8-1(d)-(f) of the Illinois Park District Code ("General Practices Manual") including Section 4.13, which establishes a process for solicitation, screening and selection board appointees in the event of a vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the Park Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the Park District to fill the vacancy created by Commissioner Manno's resignation as soon as practicable, in light of the pending referendum; and

WHEREAS, Mazhar Khan has demonstrated a continuing commitment to the Morton Grove Park District, having previously run for the office of park commissioner and having applied to fill a previous Park Board vacancy; and

**WHEREAS,** Mr. Kahn has exceptional ties to the community, a strong history of volunteerism in Morton Grove, and professional experience working with a large recreational organization.

WHEREAS, Mr. Kahn is a qualified elector of the Park District, has resided within the Park District's territorial limits for at least one year prior to the appointment, is not in arrears in the payment of a tax or other indebtedness due to the Park District, and has not been convicted of any infamous crime, bribery, perjury or other felony in any court located in the United States.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MORTON GROVE PARK DISTRICT, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE:** Incorporation of Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein, and all provisions of this Ordinance shall be construed, interpreted, and enforced in accordance therewith.

**SECTION TWO: Declaration of Vacancy.** The Commissioners of the Park Board hereby recognize the resignation of Commissioner Mark Manno and declare a Park Board vacancy.

**SECTION THREE: Procedures Waiver and Appointment**. The Park Board hereby waives the procedures set forth in Section 4.13 of the General Practices Manual, and hereby appoints Mazhar Kahn to the Morton Grove Park District Board of Park Commissioners effective upon the adoption and publication of this ordinance, to serve the remaining unexpired term of former commissioner Mark Manno.

**SECTION FIVE: Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
