





BRIEF HISTORY In 1984 the Morton Grove Historical Society (founded in 1970) in partnership with the Morton Grove Park District, purchased and moved the Haupt-Yehl House. It was built in 1888 and relocated from its original location on Lincoln Avenue and McVicker to its present site in Harrer Park. The Historical Society and Park District cooperate in maintaining and operating the Museum and Education Center. The museum collects and displays artifacts of significance to Morton Grove, including those of the original inhabitants, early settlers and of more recent additions to the community. The Morton Grove Historical Museum opened to the public in 1986 followed by the Education Center in 2008.



WHAT'S NEW AT THE PARKS

Palma Lane Park The project has been completed. Features include new playground equipment, a walking path, a park shelter, a basketball court, upgrades to the ball field, and landscaping.

The National Park Project Plans have been submitted to the Village Building Department, and the permit for this project has been approved. The bid process has been completed with very favorable results, with a projected start date of spring 2026.

Prairie View Park Project Public meetings were held during the summer, and the project progressed with the submission of the OSLAD grant application. The OSLAD application was submitted on September 29th. The application did make it through the first round of review. We expect to hear if the project is awarded a grant in December or January.

COURT PROJECT UPDATES THE COURT PROJECTS


National Park Asphalt and fencing are complete, and the east parking lot has been replaced. The site features one tennis court, a roller hockey court, and a basketball court. This project is complete, and the courts are now open to the public for use.

Prairie View Park* The site features two tennis courts and four pickleball courts. This project is complete, and the courts are now open to the public for use.

Jacobs Park The old court was demolished, and a new basketball court was installed. This project is complete, and the public can now use the court.

Oriole Park* Two pickleball courts were added, new fencing was installed, and the basketball court was changed to allow for full-court play. This project is complete, and the courts are now open to the public for use.

*Windscreens and rebounders will be installed at Oriole and Prairie View Park courts.

HOW TO REGISTER

HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE Go to mortongroveparks.com. Click on the REGISTER NOW button in the top right corner. There you can log in.

RETURNING USERS If you have a membership or have previously registered for any Morton Grove Park District program, you already have a Webtrac account; **YOU DO NOT NEED TO CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT**. If you forgot your username and password, click on the forgot username or password, and the information will be emailed to you. The username is the email of the primary household member.

NEW TO MORTON GROVE? A household account is required for online registration. For a new customer to use our online registration system, a new user must first create a household account in RecTrac. Once a household account has been created for your family, RecTrac will automatically create your web credentials. RecTrac will use the Primary Household Member's email address as the username by default. When creating an account, you will create a password.

PLEASE NOTE: You must have a date of birth on your account, or you will not be allowed to register online. You will see the login window and proceed with the username. New to Morton Grove. In Rec Trac, a newly created household will be set as a non-resident until you bring into Guest Services proof of residency. Two forms of identification are required to establish residency (State ID and utility bill (Nicor, Water, or ComEd)).

PAYMENT PLANS

The Morton Grove Park District offers a payment plans for Fitness memberships and designated recreation programs. An automatic debit is processed on a monthly basis from either a checking or credit card account. There is a service charge of \$25 for all returned checks. In addition, for every payment that is declined via the automatic payment plan, there will also be a \$25 service charge.
